Shall the special 1 percent sales and use tax for education currently in effect in Irwin County be continued for a period of time not to exceed 20 calendar quarters and for the raising of not more than \$5,750,000 for the purposes of acquiring, constructing, repairing, improving, renovating, adding to, extending, upgrading, and equipping school buildings, athletic facilities, and support facilities in the Irwin County School District useful or desirable in connection therewith, including acquiring any necessary property therefor, both real and personal, specifically including the following: (1) capital expenditures associated with planning for future elementary and secondary educational and related facilities; (2) payments of principal and interest coming due during the sales and use tax imposition period on the School District's Certificates of Participation (Irwin County, Georgia School District Refunding and Capital Improvement Project), Series 2020; (3) purchasing safety and security equipment and improvements; (4) improvements to athletic facilities including, but not limited to, the track, basketball court, and wrestling facility improvements; (5) purchasing administrative and instructional technology upgrades and equipment; (6) purchasing school buses and transportation and maintenance equipment and vehicles; (7) improvements to cafeterias, to include furnishings and equipment; (8) roof repairs including gutters and downspouts; (9) purchasing agricultural, vocational, music, drama, physical education and instructional equipment and resources; (10) purchasing textbooks, including e-books and other electronic instructional materials; and (11) paying expenses incident to accomplishing the foregoing?
